We will visit at least the following cities and places:

- ✦ Start in Kiel at 1st of April 2012
- ✦ Stralsund - 6th of April
- ✦ Danzig - 21th of April
- ✦ Kaliningrad - 26th of April
- ✦ Klaipeda - 2nd of May
- ✦ Riga - 14th of May
- ✦ Tallinn - 27th of May
- ✦ St. Petersburg - 7th of June
- ✦ Helsinki - 19th of June
- ✦ Turku - 26th of June
- ✦ Vaasa - 6th of July
- ✦ Haparanda (with trip to the North Cape) - 20th of July
- ✦ Stockholm - 25th of August
- ✦ Copenhagen - 26th of September
- ✦ Kerteminde - 2nd of October
- ✦ Arrival in Kiel beginning of October 2012



Our plan is to sail round the Baltic Sea in anti-clockwise direction, but this may be subject to change due to wind and weather conditions. Especially the noted dates are uncertain.

What can we do for harbour porpoises?

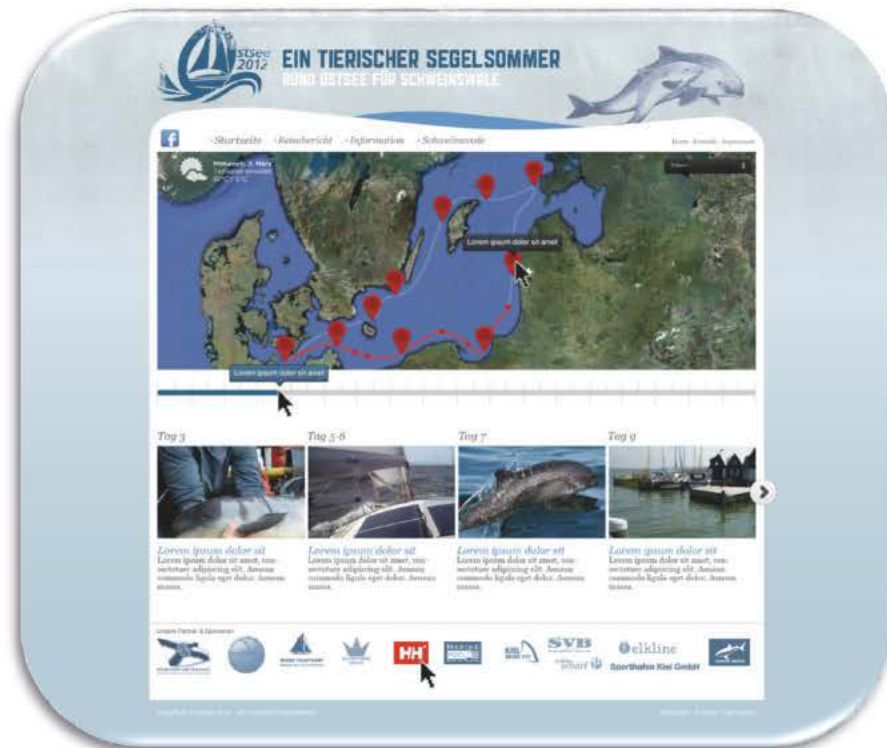
-  We will inform about harbour porpoises in public presentations (travel reports in conjunction with harbour porpoise presentations)
-  We will place reports about our activities in regional and water sports press (segeln, Segler Zeitung)
-  We will visit scientific research institutions as in Kerteminde and the SAMBAH representatives in the different countries
-  We encourage the SAMBAH representatives to inform about our project in their countries in order to extend our publicity
-  We report sightings as well as non-sightings of harbour porpoises during our tour

-  Reports and blogs about our activities, introduction of a harbour porpoise newsletter

What can we do for harbour porpoises?

- 🐬 We collect donations through our web site
- 🐬 Our sailing guests will donate for harbour porpoises
- 🐬 We will create an ownband and sell it on our farewell party and maybe through the press in Kiel, all revenue will be donated
- 🐬 We sail to porpoise click detectors and report about them.
- 🐬 We will advert our project through different other organisations like WDCS and the German Cruiser Yacht Association (Kreuzer Abteilung)
- 🐬 We call attention of water sports enthusiasts to the importance of sighting reports

What can we do for harbour porpoises?

- 🐬 We create crew clothing with the logos of SAMBAH and / or other organisations
- 🐬 Our ship can hold as presentation area, e.g. with the SAMBAH logo printed on the main sail
- 🐬 We will place a picture of two harbour porpoises on the bow of our boat
- 🐬 We will hoist a flag on our forestay in harbours
